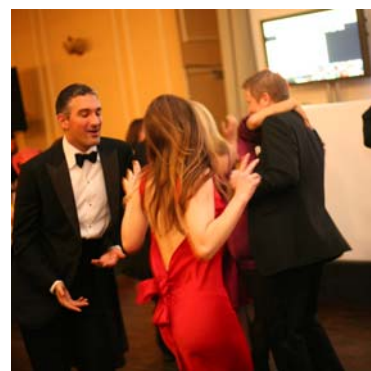
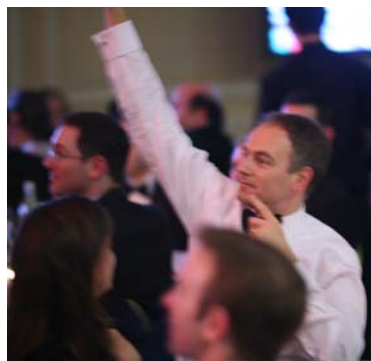

## 'The Angus Sunlight Project'

The project removes children from labour in mines as well as preventing others from entering and spreading awareness about the risks involved. Use of child labour is widespread, driven by poverty and ignorance of the associated health risks.



The gold deposits in the Upper Eastern Region are not enough to attract investment from the major mining companies down south, but the **illegal shafts, dug over 80m deep** into the ground produce enough to enrich a few local mine owners and are **a magnet for the poor, the desperate and the orphaned of the region.**

Children are cheap labour and are in the mines because they need to support themselves and their families.

This destructive convergence of circumstances has meant the **growth of child labour was inevitable but Operation Sunlight has proved that it need not be intractable.**

*"I have been a miner myself and that is why I'm so passionate about this work. It is so tempting. There is a fever in it that can take you out of school easily... and that is why when I see the children that have said goodbye to gold mining forever, I really respect them"*
